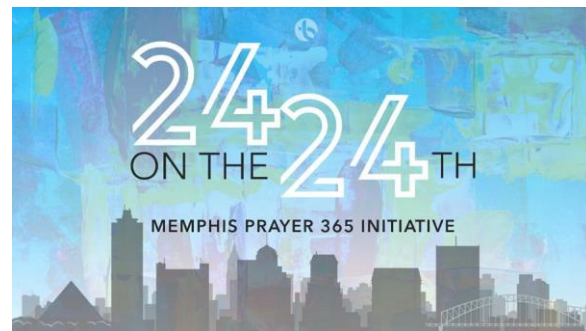


PRAYER GUIDE
