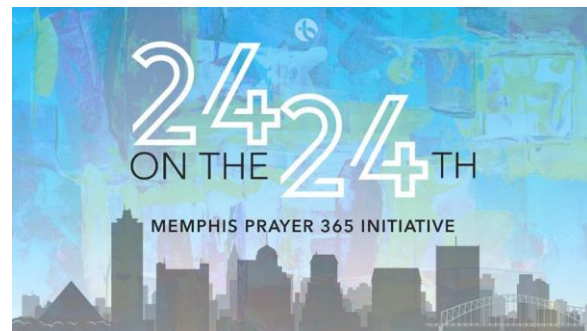


PRAYER GUIDE
