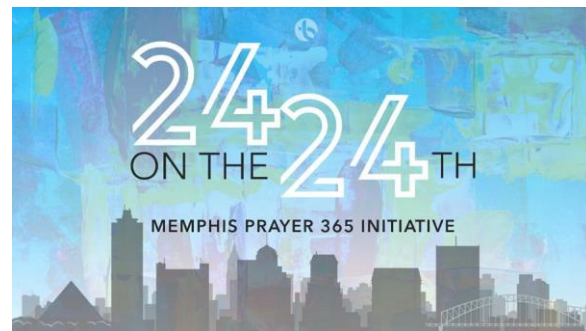


PRAYER GUIDE
