I started teaching children from 11 to 14 years old. They are Alexa, Dilan, Matías, Yosef, and Livni. They are children of Christian parents yet they are fickle. We deeply appreciate your prayers so that we can move forward. We have confidence in the Lord that His word does not return empty. It is a wonderful privilege, but we are human and sometimes we feel sad for not seeing results soon.
