It has often been said that we are a nation most blessed. The United States of America, founded on July 4, 1776, has been a nation of unprecedented prosperity and peace, while at the same time we have suffered the consequences of ignoring and rejecting God's Word. With the 250th anniversary of this nation coming soon, we call upon the Church to pray for revival.

On Tuesday evening, September 9, I texted our pastoral staff about a desire I had to connect a prayer effort with the 250th anniversary of the United States of America, which will be on July 4, 2026.

Here's an idea. Nov 17 is 250 days before the USA 250th anniversary on July 4, 2026.

What if we challenge the church to pray for revival and a move of God in the U.S. for 250 days straight until July 4?

There are a variety of resources I think we could utilize. Feel free to search around in your spare time for anything that would apply.

We could do a social media campaign, incorporate weekly or monthly into SS, worship, Lifeline (our monthly newsletter), etc.

Then I added, "Not to be a worship America kind of thing, but specific prayer for revival, repentance, etc."

I sometimes text ideas to our staff to prompt thinking, and then we discuss them when we all get together. In this case, events of the following day precluded any discussion we would have had about this idea.

September 10, 2025 may very well have changed the course of America. That day may have sparked revival in the U.S. the likes of which has not been seen in many generations.

The assassination of a young man of God, a generational leader, became an immediate catalyst for recognizing a movement of God. I am not saying God began doing something that day, because God is always at work!

But maybe, the horrible event of September 10 has resulted in millions opening their eyes to Who God is and What He is doing.

I recall September 11, 2001 very well. I remember sitting at our breakfast table when the first tower was hit. I remember going to the office and rolling a tv cart into the receptionist's office so we could all gather around and follow the reports. (That was before we all had streaming devices in our hands or on our screens.) Within moments, the second tower was hit.

9/11 sparked a surge in church attendance for the following few weeks and months. But did we see a national revival? Did we see hearts turning to God, repentance of sin, and a passion to know and obey Him?

Like many "revival meetings" long held in evangelical churches, revival was often little more than a series of meetings, pizza night for the youth and hot dog night for the kids, pack-a-pew nights, an engaging revivalist, but often no lasting results.

While those were enjoyable in my growing up years, they went by the wayside due to hectic schedules, 2-parent working homes, and an explosion of weeknight sports & activities for children that became a higher priority than church.

What is being experienced presently in the United States is a phenomenon that is virtually unknown to our middle and younger adult generations. They might have heard of revivals, but very few have ever experienced revival personally or culturally.

We desperately need revival, personally, corporately in our local churches, and culturally across our land.

Pray 250 is born out of that realization.

This prayer guide is divided into seven weekly themes:

- Monday – Revival in the Church
- Tuesday – Leadership, Justice, & Government
- Wednesday – Unity, Healing, & Restoration
- Thursday – Families, Youth, & the Next Generation
- Friday – Culture, Media & Truth
- Saturday – Evangelism, Missions, & Hope for the Nation
- Sunday – Personal Repentance and Renewal

Along with each day's theme is a Bible verse, followed by a prayer prompt. This is not intended to be a specific prayer for the reader to recite, but a prompt to guide your personal plea to Almighty God.

You will notice that each theme, verse, and prayer are repeated several times. This is to remind us of the importance of persevering in prayer, rather than bouncing from one request to another, often failing to remain steadfast in making our requests known unto the Lord.

Finally, blank space is available on each day to enable you to write specific requests for your personal revival, local church, community, and cultural needs, etc.

Join us on the Pray 250 journey, from Pampa, Texas to around the United States of America. Let us, together, call on the Lord to send revival to our nation once again.

Day 1 – Monday, October 27, 2025

Theme: Revival in the Church

Verse: Psalm 85:6 – “Will You not revive us again, that Your people may rejoice in You?”

Prayer:

Lord, I come today asking You to breathe new life into Your Church. Stir pastors, leaders, and congregations to seek You with renewed hunger. Let worship and prayer awaken our hearts. Revive me personally, Lord, so that my faith overflows into the lives of those around me. May every meeting, gathering, and conversation bring glory to You.

Day 2 – Tuesday, October 28, 2025

Theme: Leadership, Justice & Government

Verse: Proverbs 14:34 – “Righteousness exalts a nation, but sin is a reproach to any people.”

Prayer:

Father, I lift up our nation's leaders today. Give them wisdom, courage, and integrity. Let Your justice guide every decision. Strengthen those who choose what is right and expose corruption. May America's leaders seek You first and lead with humility. Help me pray faithfully and act wisely in my own community.

Day 3 – Wednesday, October 29, 2025

Theme: Unity, Healing & Reconciliation

Verse: Ephesians 4:3 – “Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.”

Prayer:

Lord, our nation feels divided, but You call us to peace. Heal wounds, restore relationships, and teach us forgiveness. Begin in my heart, Lord, and let my actions reflect Your love. Help me be a peacemaker in my family, church, and community. May unity in Christ shine brightly.

Day 4 – Thursday, October 30, 2025

Theme: Families, Youth & the Next Generation

Verse: Joel 2:28 – “I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh; your sons and daughters shall prophesy.”

Prayer:

Father, bless our homes and families. Guide parents with patience and love. Protect children from harm and confusion. Inspire youth to seek You wholeheartedly. May our homes be centers of faith, hope, and joy. Let the next generation rise to follow You boldly.

Day 5 – Friday, October 31, 2025

Theme: Culture, Media & Truth

Verse: Matthew 5:14 – “You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden.”

Prayer:

Lord, help me reflect Your light in a culture full of noise and distraction. Use me to share truth and goodness in my words, actions, and work. Inspire artists, creators, and leaders to uplift rather than mislead. May our society see Your glory through lives surrendered to You.

Day 6 – Saturday, November 1, 2025

Theme: Evangelism, Missions & Hope for the Nation

Verse: Mark 16:15 – “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation.”

Prayer:

Jesus, give me boldness to share Your hope. Open hearts in my neighborhood, workplace, and church. Bless missionaries and ministries spreading Your Word. May revival flow through communities across our nation, awakening hearts and drawing people closer to You.

Day 7 – Sunday, November 2, 2025

Theme: Personal Repentance & Renewal

Verse: 1 John 1:9 – “If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.”

Prayer:

Lord, search my heart and show me where I need Your cleansing. Forgive my sins and restore my passion for You. Let me walk humbly, love deeply, and serve faithfully. May every day bring me closer to Your heart.

Day 8 – Monday, November 3, 2025

Theme: Revival in the Church

Verse: Haggai 2:9 – “The glory of this latter house shall be greater than the former.”

Prayer:

Father, I pray that Your Church becomes a shining light in our nation. Strengthen our leaders and encourage all believers to serve with zeal. Let worship, prayer, and teaching transform hearts. Revive us so that we reflect Your glory to the world.

Day 9 – Tuesday, November 4, 2025

Theme: Leadership, Justice & Government

Verse: Micah 6:8 – “Do justice, love kindness, and walk humbly with your God.”

Prayer:

Lord, teach our leaders to govern with wisdom, mercy, and humility. Expose injustice and strengthen righteousness. Help me to support and pray for those in authority and to act with integrity in my own life.

Day 10 – Wednesday, November 5, 2025

Theme: Unity, Healing & Reconciliation

Verse: Psalm 133:1 – “Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brothers to dwell together in unity.”

Prayer:

Father, let Your Spirit heal divisions. Teach forgiveness and understanding. Let my actions promote peace and reconciliation. Use Your people to demonstrate what unity looks like in a broken world.

Day 11 – Thursday, November 6, 2025

Theme: Families, Youth & the Next Generation

Verse: Proverbs 22:6 – “Train up a child in the way he should go, even when he grows old he will not depart from it.”

Prayer:

Lord, bless families to nurture faith in children. Give parents patience, wisdom, and love. Inspire youth to seek You. Let homes be places of learning, prayer, and joy, raising a generation that follows You faithfully.

Day 12 – Friday, November 7, 2025

Theme: Culture, Media & Truth

Verse: Philippians 4:8 – “Whatever is true, honorable, right, pure, lovely, admirable, excellent, worthy of praise — think on these things.”

Prayer:

God, help me fill my mind and heart with truth and goodness. Use me to bring light into conversations, media, and art. Guide society toward integrity and wisdom. May Your principles shape culture and inspire people toward righteousness.

Day 13 – Saturday, November 8, 2025

Theme: Evangelism, Missions & Hope for the Nation

Verse: Habakkuk 2:14 – “The earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the LORD as the waters cover the sea.”

Prayer:

Lord, help me see opportunities to share Your hope. Bless those spreading the gospel near and far. May revival touch every community, awakening hearts and transforming lives across our nation.

Day 14 – Sunday, November 9, 2025

Theme: Personal Repentance & Renewal

Verse: Psalm 51:10 – “Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.”

Prayer:

Lord, purify my heart and restore my spirit. Forgive me where I've wandered. Strengthen my faith, focus, and love. May I be a vessel of Your light and grace, ready for all You call me to do.

Day 15 – Monday, November 10, 2025

Theme: Revival in the Church

Verse: Acts 2:17 – “I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh.”

Prayer:

Father, pour Your Spirit on the Church. Ignite passion, deepen faith, and inspire action. Let believers seek You with fresh hunger, share Your love freely, and demonstrate Your power in their lives.

Day 16 – Tuesday, November 11, 2025

Theme: Leadership, Justice & Government

Verse: 1 Timothy 2:1-2 – "I exhort, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people, for kings and all who are in authority..."

Prayer:

Lord, help leaders govern with justice, wisdom, and humility. Strengthen those who seek righteousness, and bring reform where needed. May I support them with prayer, discernment, and integrity in my own life.

Day 17 – Wednesday, November 12, 2025

Theme: Unity, Healing & Reconciliation

Verse: Colossians 3:13 – "Bear with one another and forgive each other if anyone has a complaint against another; forgive as the Lord forgave you."

Prayer:

Father, teach me to forgive and bear with others. Heal divisions around me and in our nation. May I promote peace, understanding, and reconciliation, reflecting Christ in my words and actions.

Day 18 – Thursday, November 13, 2025

Theme: Families, Youth & the Next Generation

Verse: Ephesians 6:4 – "Bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord."

Prayer:

Lord, guide parents and guardians to raise children with love and wisdom. Protect young hearts and minds. Inspire youth to pursue You. Let our homes be sanctuaries of faith, learning, and hope.

Day 19 – Friday, November 14, 2025

Theme: Culture, Media & Truth

Day 21 – Sunday, November 16, 2025

Theme: Personal Repentance & Renewal

Verse: Lamentations 3:40 – “Let us examine and probe our ways, and turn back to the LORD.”

Prayer:

Father, search my heart and reveal areas of sin and neglect. Restore my devotion to You. Let me walk daily in Your presence, humble and ready to serve. Refresh my spirit, Lord, and renew my commitment to You.

Day 22 – Monday, November 17, 2025

Theme: Revival in the Church

Verse: Ephesians 5:18 – “Be filled with the Spirit.”

Prayer:

Lord, fill Your Church with Your Spirit. Inspire worship, prayer, and love. Let believers shine with faith and hope. May revival begin in my heart and flow outward into every gathering, city, and community.

Day 23 – Tuesday, November 18, 2025

Theme: Leadership, Justice & Government

Verse: Psalm 72:1 – “Give the king Your judgments, O God, and Your righteousness to the king's son.”

Prayer:

Father, grant leaders wisdom and discernment. Strengthen their integrity. Help them act justly and lead humbly. May Your guidance direct the nation's steps toward righteousness and blessing.

Prayer:

Lord, give me wisdom to navigate media, education, and culture. Let truth guide my words, actions, and choices. May I influence others for good, and may culture reflect Your light and righteousness through me.

Day 27 – Saturday, November 22, 2025

Theme: Evangelism, Missions & Hope for the Nation

Verse: Acts 1:8 – “You will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you shall be My witnesses...”

Prayer:

Father, fill me with Your Spirit so I can boldly share the gospel. Use me to witness in my community, family, and workplace. Multiply the impact of every believer sharing Your truth, and bring revival across our land.

Day 28 – Sunday, November 23, 2025

Theme: Personal Repentance & Renewal

Verse: Psalm 34:18 – “The LORD is near to the brokenhearted and saves the crushed in spirit.”

Prayer:

Lord, search my heart for pride, selfishness, or doubt. Heal my broken places and restore joy in Your presence. Let me walk humbly, trusting You, and allow Your Spirit to renew every part of my life.

Day 29 – Monday, November 24, 2025

Theme: Revival in the Church

Verse: Colossians 3:16 – “Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom...”

Prayer:

Father, let Your Word transform our churches. Teach, correct, and inspire every believer to live out Your truth. Revive hearts to love You more fully, and may congregations become centers of worship, hope, and faith.

Day 30 – Tuesday, November 25, 2025

Theme: Leadership, Justice & Government

Verse: Isaiah 1:17 – “Learn to do good; seek justice, correct oppression, bring justice to the fatherless, plead the widow's cause.”

Prayer:

Lord, teach leaders to act justly and care for the vulnerable. Strengthen their courage and discernment. May the nation reflect Your righteousness, and may I support and pray for justice in my own community.

Day 31 – Wednesday, November 26, 2025

Theme: Unity, Healing & Reconciliation

Verse: Romans 12:18 – “If possible, so far as it depends on you, be at peace with all men.”

Prayer:

Father, let Your peace flow through me. Heal strained relationships and encourage reconciliation in my circles. Help me be humble, patient, and a source of unity. May Your Church model Your love to a divided world.

Day 32 – Thursday, November 27, 2025

Theme: Families, Youth & the Next Generation

Verse: Deuteronomy 6:6-7 – “Impress them on your children. Talk of them when you sit at home, walk by the way, lie down, rise up.”

Prayer:

Lord, help families prioritize faith. May parents and mentors guide children with love, patience, and prayer. Inspire youth to follow You and honor their families. Let homes be places where Your truth is lived and taught daily.

Day 33 – Friday, November 28, 2025

Theme: Culture, Media & Truth

Verse: Isaiah 60:1 – “Arise, shine; for your light has come, and the glory of the LORD has risen upon you.”

Prayer:

Father, empower me to shine Your light in culture, media, and community. Help me reflect Your glory in all I do. Let Your truth and beauty penetrate hearts and minds through the influence of believers everywhere.

Day 34 – Saturday, November 29, 2025

Lord, help me represent You faithfully. May my words, actions, and attitudes draw others to You. Bless missionaries and outreach efforts nationwide. Let revival begin locally and expand to every community in our nation.

Day 35 – Sunday, November 30, 2025

Theme: Personal Repentance & Renewal

Verse: Isaiah 1:18 – “Though your sins are like scarlet, they will be as white as snow...”

Prayer:

Lord, wash away my sins and purify my heart. Restore my love for You and my willingness to obey. Renew my spirit and help me live fully in Your grace, reflecting Your holiness to those around me.

Day 36 – Monday, December 1, 2025

Theme: Revival in the Church

Verse: Hebrews 10:24-25 – “Consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds, not forsaking our own assembling together...”

Prayer:

Day 40 – Friday, December 5, 2025

Verse: Colossians 3:17 – “Whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus.”

Prayer:

Father, help me honor You in all I do. Let my speech, work, and creativity reflect Your wisdom and goodness. May culture be transformed as believers live with integrity, sharing Your truth in every sphere of influence.

Day 41 – Saturday, December 6, 2025

Prayer:

Father, help me honor the unity You provide. Heal divisions and foster inclusivity and compassion. Let believers demonstrate Your love, bridging gaps in race, culture, and ideology. May Your Church model true unity.

Day 46 – Thursday, December 11, 2025

Theme: Families, Youth & the Next Generation

Verse: Psalm 128:3-4 – “Your wife shall be like a fruitful vine in your house; your children like olive plants around your table.”

Prayer:

Lord, bless marriages and children. Guide families to flourish in faith and love. Protect children from harm, and help parents nurture wisdom, patience, and devotion. Let homes reflect Your care and guidance.

Day 47 – Friday, December 12, 2025

Theme: Culture, Media & Truth

Verse: Proverbs 16:3 – “Commit your works to the LORD, and your plans will be established.”

Prayer:

Father, I commit my actions, speech, and creativity to You. Let culture reflect Your values through the faithful work of believers. Guide decisions and projects so that Your glory is revealed in every sphere.

Day 48 – Saturday, December 13, 2025

Theme: Evangelism, Missions & Hope for the Nation

Verse: Isaiah 6:8 – “Here am I, send me!”

Prayer:

Lord, send me as Your ambassador. Open doors for ministry and service. Give courage to proclaim Your gospel and compassion to serve those in need. May revival sweep across our nation, touching every life.

Day 49 – Sunday, December 14, 2025

Theme: Personal Repentance & Renewal

Verse: Romans 12:2 – “Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind.”

Prayer:

Lord, transform my thoughts, priorities, and habits. Help me resist worldly distractions and live fully for You. Renew my mind and spirit, guiding my daily choices to honor You.

Day 50 – Monday, December 15, 2025

Theme: Revival in the Church

Verse: Psalm 51:13 – “Then I will teach transgressors Your ways, and sinners will be converted to You.”

Prayer:

Father, revive the Church so that it becomes a beacon of hope and teaching. Let leaders and members be vessels of Your truth, guiding others toward salvation. May revival begin in my heart and flow outward to all those I meet.

Day 51 – Tuesday, December 16, 2025

Theme: Leadership, Justice & Government

Verse: Deuteronomy 16:20 – “Justice, and only justice, you shall pursue...”

Prayer:

Lord, inspire our leaders to pursue true justice in every decision. Strengthen their integrity and humility. Let righteousness guide every policy and action, and help me pray faithfully for those in authority.

Day 52 – Wednesday, December 17, 2025

Theme: Unity, Healing & Reconciliation

Verse: James 3:18 – “And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace.”

Prayer:

Father, let peace be the foundation of my actions. Help me sow love and reconciliation in every relationship. Heal divisions in my community and Church, reflecting Your unity and grace.

Day 53 – Thursday, December 18, 2025

Theme: Families, Youth & the Next Generation

Verse: Isaiah 54:13 – “All your children shall be taught by the LORD, and great shall be the peace of your children.”

Prayer:

Lord, bless children and youth with understanding and faith. Guide parents and teachers to nurture them in Your truth. May families become strong spiritual foundations for the next generation.

Day 54 – Friday, December 19, 2025

Theme: Culture, Media & Truth

Verse: 1 Peter 3:15 – “Always be ready to give an answer for the hope that is in you, with gentleness and respect.”

Prayer:
